ADONAY (MY FOUNDATION)

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The word Adonay / Adonai is commonly translated as My Lord / My Master, but it doesn't mean that. More properly Adonay means My Foundation. Modern languages have evolved to serve peoples arrogance, and only a small percentage of people translate the Hebrew word Adonay with a proper equivalent My Foundation. The Hebrew word Ba'al is actually what translates as Lord.

The Hebrew word Adon means Foundation. So when a person says My Adon, that's the same as saying Adonay.

Adonay & Adon (My Foundation & Foundation) are proper titles to use for the Almighty Yah (Abba & Messiah), but they should never be used as a replacement for Abba's Name! Especially in the Scriptures! Abba's Forever Name should be in the Original Covenant about 6,823 times, as well as many times in the New Covenant! But the Yahudim (Jews) banned saying or writing Abba's Name thousands of years ago. However the use of Thy Name is being restored by people around the world! Abba's Forever Name is written from right to left \$131 Paleo Hebrew & The Modern Hebrew, starting with Yah, but Thy whole name is pronounced (YaHuWaH - YahWeh - YaHoVaH - Etc.), depending on various view points.

Yes, Thy Forever Name is important! However, Obedience To Yah & Intimacy With Yah is even more important!
